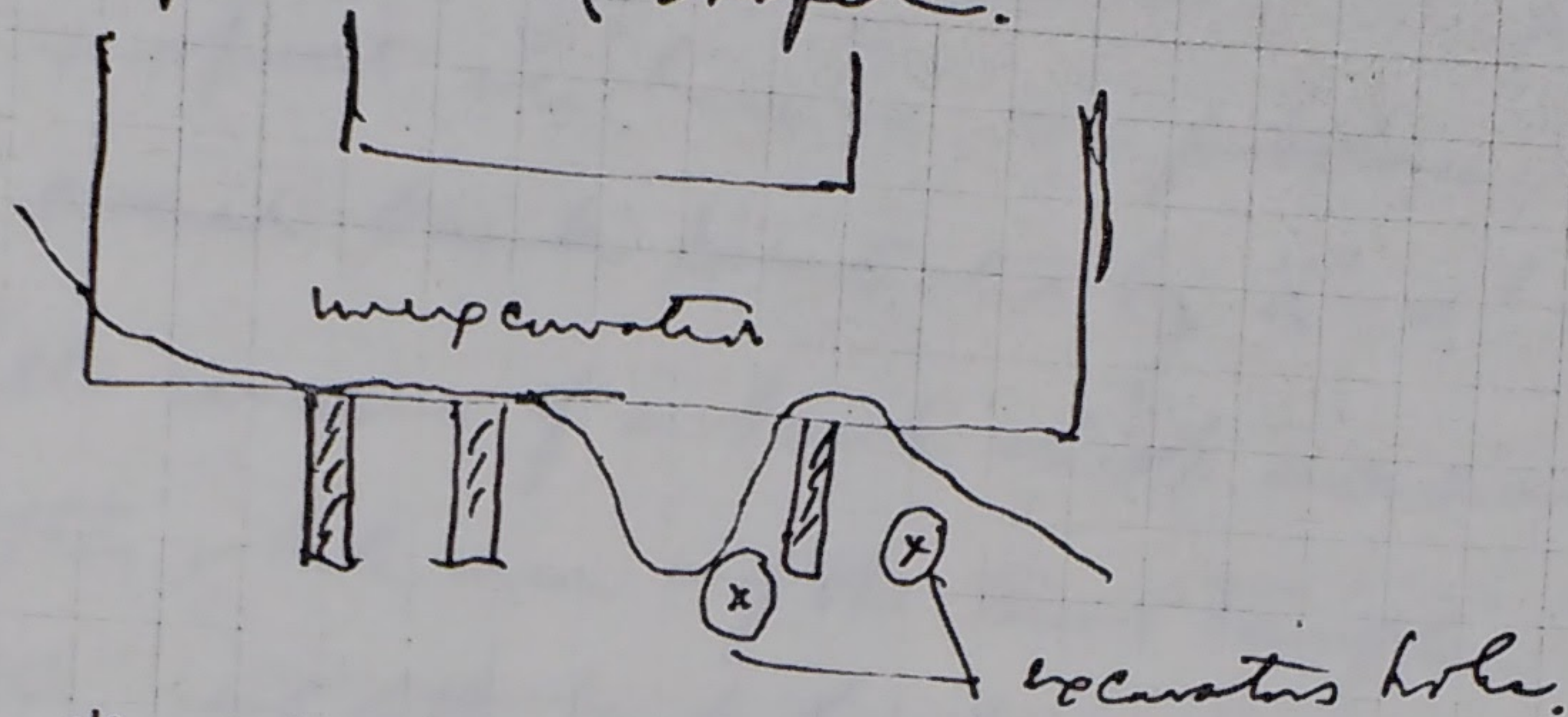

The chapel appears to have had ③
three chambers. Previous excavators (Europeans?)
have been rooting around in a futile
aimless way. [At IV there is a stone of
the chapel inscribed "PÜCKLER"
"MUSKAU"]

- (9) Carried trenches a-d W of Building 700
to hard black "gebel". All showed the
same strata. The surface, uneven and
covered with stones, has resulted from
weathered schot digging.

The strata are everywhere the
same, — above a layer of 30-50 cm
of schot bearing dirt (pot shards) the decay
of an ancient building; then about 100-120 cm
of red sand, natural detritus from Gebel Barkal;
then a hard bank of alluvial mud.
After finishing a-d, resumed work on a'-d'
