The objects are dumped in the hole—not laid out in order. No inscription is visible on any of the objects. The bronzes might be XVIIIth dyn., but the pottery looks later (ca XXth). However the material is scanty, and the conclusion must be used with caution.

(4) Continued work at Nuri, clearing U. face of Pyr. VIII, caved-in hole in front of chapel.
