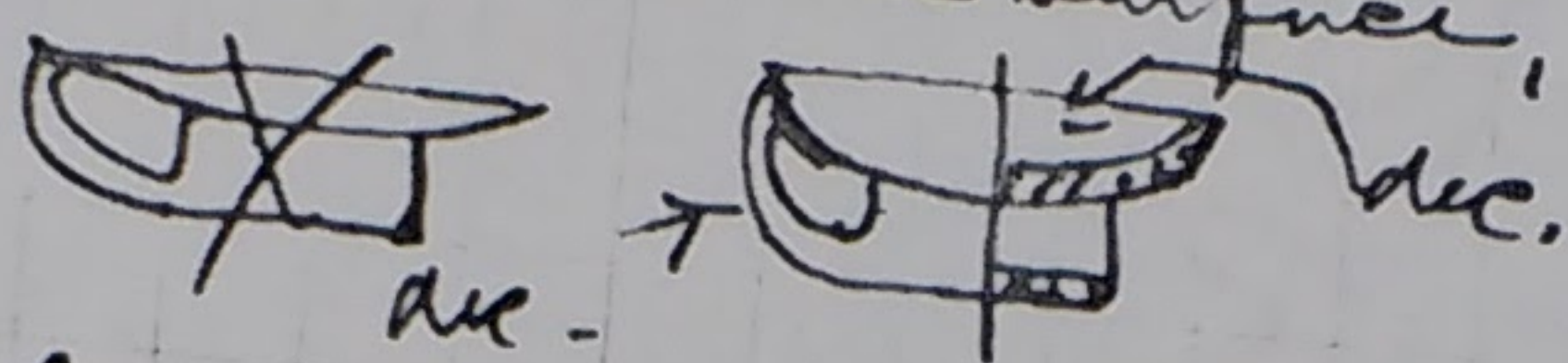

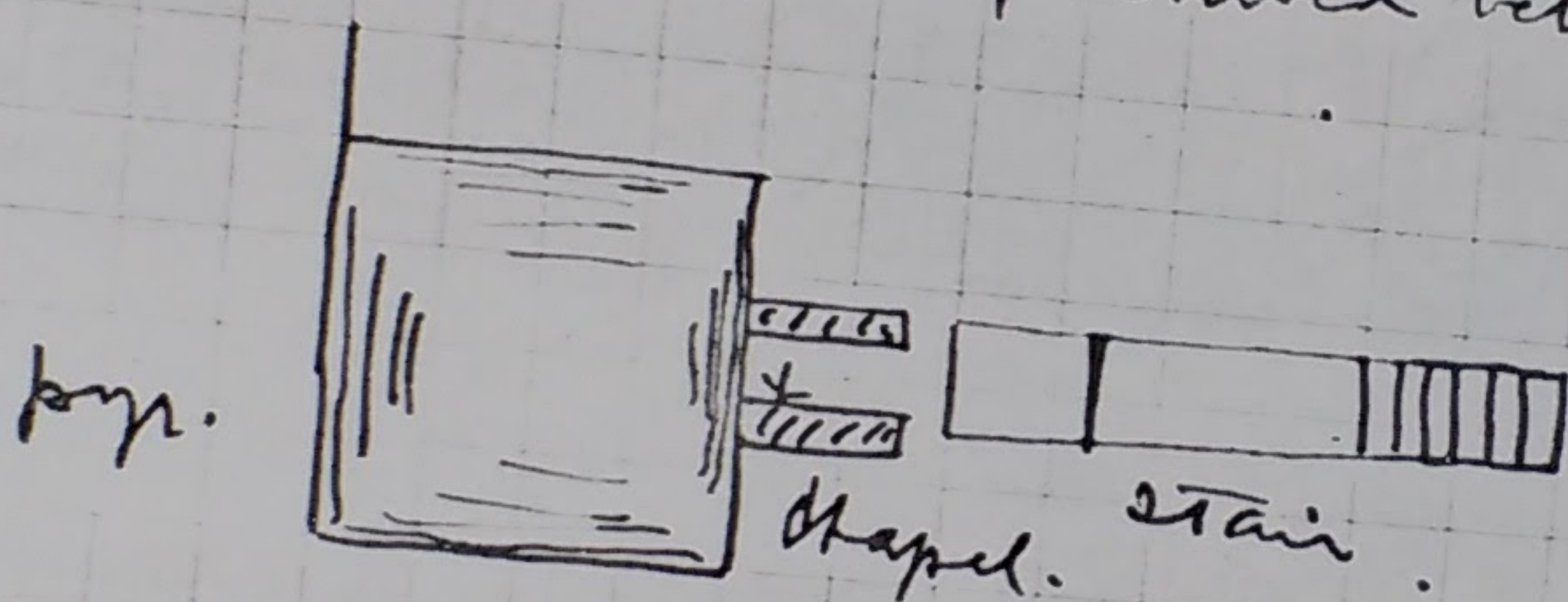
Clearing chamber of XV. Here

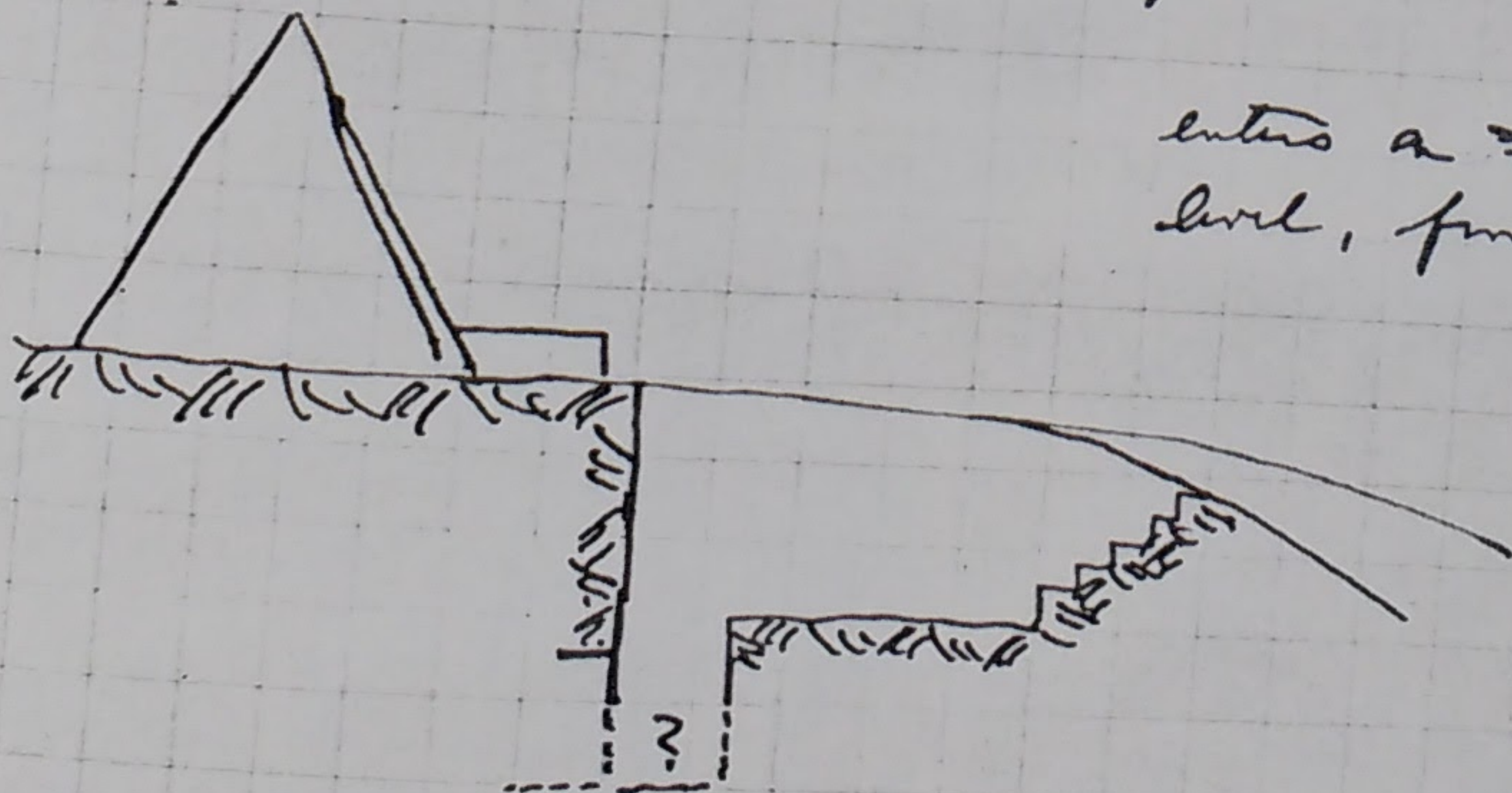

missing. The chapel is preserved to
a height of two courses. Traces of relief
(man on the one) on one side. Red sandstone.
The stair descends a few steps, then comes
a level place, then a pit. The stair

enters a ~~the~~ lower
level, from the slope.
