- ③ AT Nuri worked on page VIII and
Chapel of XVI. In the niche of XVI
is a roughly shaped slab of black
granite with an inscription in the
name of ~~Am~~ (Am) Ama-talakh
(or Amun-talakh). The inscription
is Egyptian. The position of the
pyramid seems to point to its late
date.

AT VIII, the corridor has descended to
the roof vault between the first and
second rooms. This vault (of masonry)
has fallen and room 2 is involved
in the general ruin.
