(62) inside the wall was drift dirt.

(3) At 900 continued clearing towards river. Here there are some super-imposed late walls with floors. About 100-120 cm above the floor of rm. 904.

In room 901 removed the debris down to red sand. In the GU quarter and along the [XX??] wall this was debris of decal with a weather surface about on & level with the top of the second foundation course (2 f.c.). Some col. drums were on this. The debris in the rest of the room had been disturbed in modern times, and contained a number of the col. drums. Under the two cols. of which parts remain standing runs a stone floor. These two appear to belong to the earlier building.
