## Friday April 20 76<sup>th</sup> day of work

Employed 118 men at Barkal on misc. cleaning jobs and 66 at Nuri filling in VIII A. and stair.

Telegram from Kemp, that he returns on next boat.

I worked on 500 plan all day. Dunham on object register.

## Saturday April 22 77<sup>th</sup> day of work

Employed 114 men at Barkal (instead of usual 220) and about 65 at Nuri, as yesterday.

Dunham and I at Barkal on maps and register.

## Sunday April 23 78<sup>th</sup> day

Men employed on putting house in village in order, carrying stones, etc.

Dunham and I stayed at Merowe, packing up. Repacked gold objects from Nuri VIII putting greater part in small wooden box together with bracelet from Barkal VIII, to be taken down in my personal luggage. Telegram to Antik [?] to that effect: "fragile objects" to prevent Egypt. officials understanding.

Also packed drawing material, photo. outfit, and medicines to stay in house at Merowe.

Dunham and I ran down to Palace in launch and had lunch with Governor Jackson. Mr. Young also there.
