

- Feb 8th (Cont) (3) Worked at construction of E end of new RR line in stone.
To serve "SW" portion
of 501 and the main [Drawing]
entrance through
Pylon.
- Feb 9th 1920 Monday 103 Locals
54th Day of work: -- At 3¹⁰ P.M. today Lord and Lady Allenby, The Sirdar, Gen.
Jackson, Governor of Dongala Province, and a group of officers
at their party, visited the excavations for an hour. Work was stopped
on their arrival. Dr. Reisner showed them over B 500, B 700, and
B 300. The party left for Kareima at 4¹⁰ P.M.
- Work on (1) B 501 "SE" quarter, (2) Construction of RR.
"W" of 501
- (1) B 501 "SE"
Feb 9th Work in areas I 1, I 2, II 2, II 3, III 2, III 3, IV 3.
In I 1, I 2 removing drift sand from Prof. Breasted's excavation
along "W" face of 2nd Pylon. In niche in face of Pylon in
area I 2 a stopper for a vessel in blue paste in the form of
a ram's head, trace of the base of a bronze headdress fastened
into socket on top of head. Also a ram's head + sun disc, and
two faï cylinders, and parts of two ordinary shawabtis.
In III 3, close to and "SW" from column c², a thieves
excavation through floor of temple. The complex of intrusive
burnt brick walls continues.
- (2) RR "IV" of 501
Feb 9th Work continued as yesterday on construction of causeway.
- Owing to high wind from the "S", about 10 AM dumping
was shifted from the "S" to the "N" dump.
