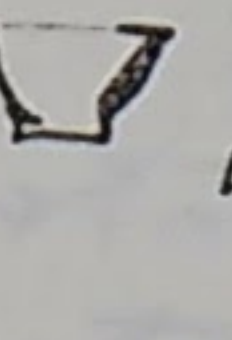

Work on ① 800 W side of pylm 163
514 ② 508-505 and 519 ③ NW. 262

- ① On the W side of pylm of 800, clearing off surface debris, and revealed a number of small poorly built rooms with floors just under present surface (probably masonry).
- ② Clearing 514, altar of Piamshi (broken in two) with debris which fills a large hole running under and out in front of the altar. In this debris, frags of black granite and various pieces (frag. of bulls head, frags of statuettes, etc.).

Clearing 508, frag. of head of statuette fits on frag. from 514.

Under corner G.D. of 579 found a pile of small model pottery vases and some other beads   which may be a foundation deposit belonging to earlier grey masonry.
