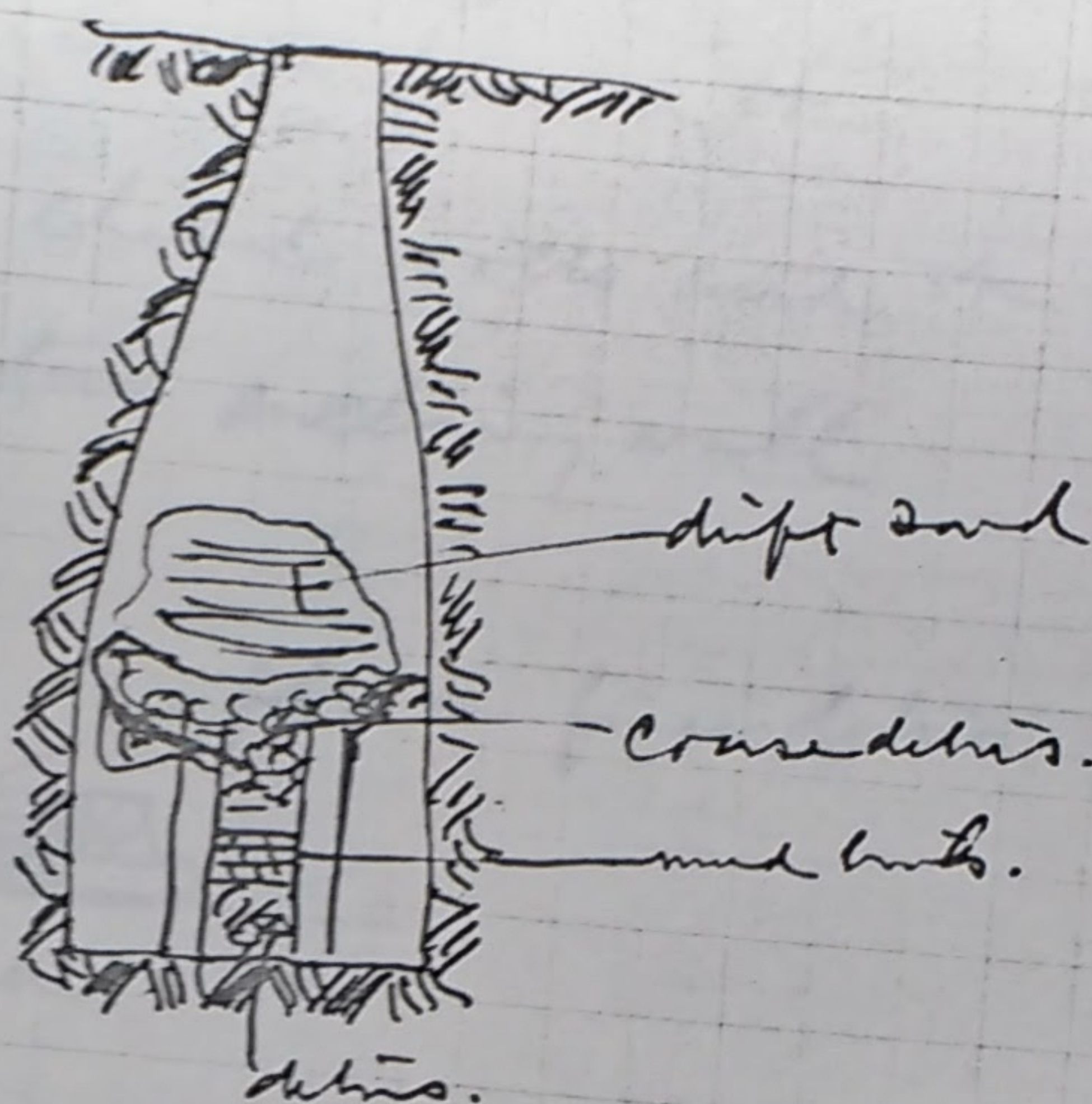


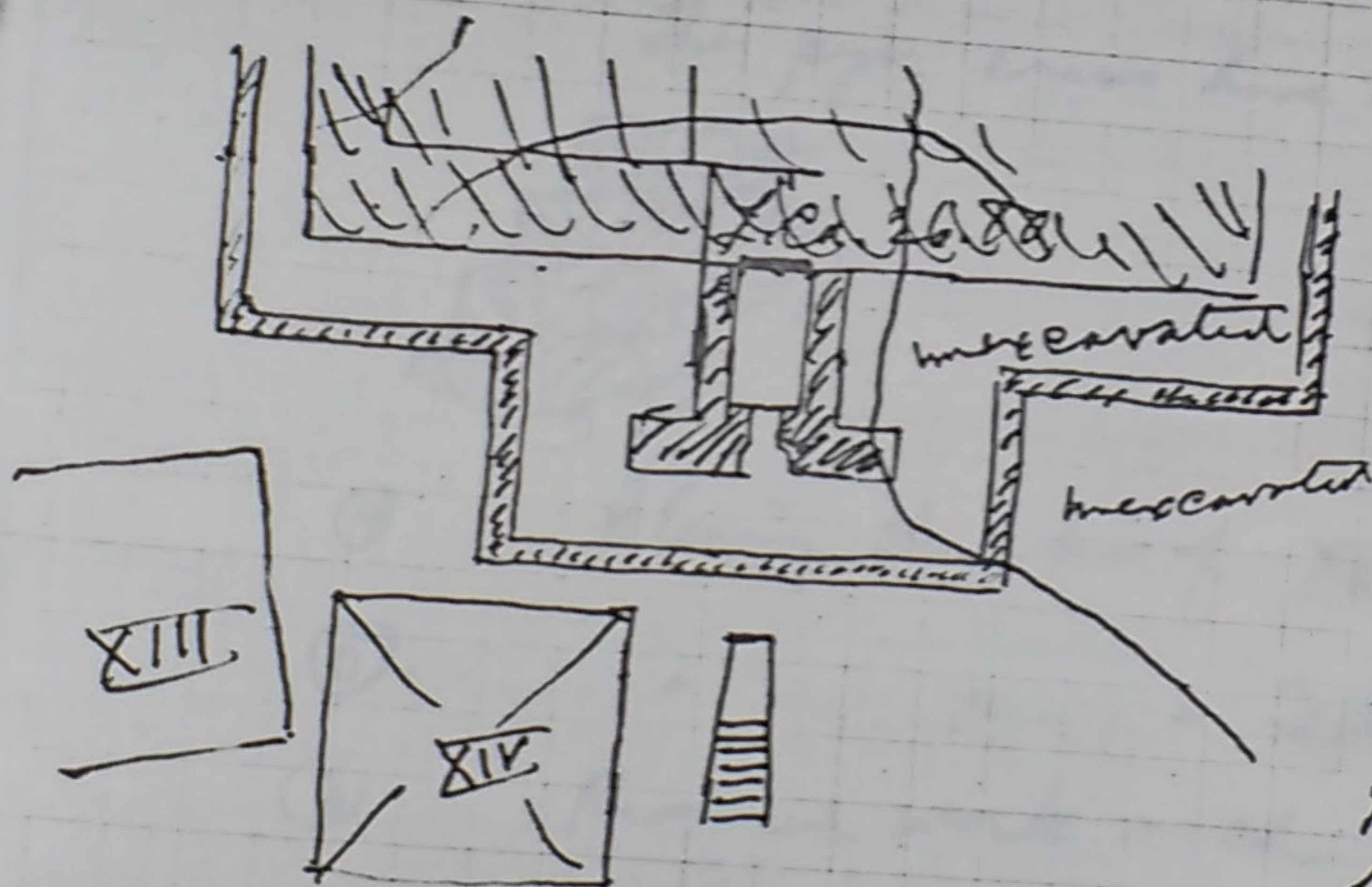

The clearing of the face of XI proceeds.



The casing is preserved to a height of ca 6 m.

The chapel is a height of 3 courses in place. The

N. wall of the chamber (i.e. the face of the pyramid) was hollowed to take a

stela now missing. The E and W walls

were carved in relief (as Pys. I-VI). The enclosing

wall formed a sort of platform level with the floor of the chapel.
