March 5th 1920 :--

75th Day of work : -- Work on (1) "N" of B 802 (2) Inside B 800.

(3) B 501.

(1) "N" of B 802 Mar. 5th : --

Work continued clearing "N" of the "NE" corner of B 802, and outside corner. Detailed cleaning of the "E" end of "N" wall of 802 shows an older mud brick wall inside the sandstone wall.

## (2) Inside B 802-801

March 5th: --

Continued cleaning of 1st (older) pavement in centre of B 802.

In B 801 cleaned a portion of the f. c. of the 2nd pavement (sections of column drums). One of these was inscribed [Drawing: Hieroglyphs], and it was noted that the square abacus block with cartouche of [Drawing: Hieroglyphs] noted on Feb 29th (5) and found in B 801, was of size corresponding to these column drums (smaller than the columns of the later reconstruction of B 800. There can be no doubt that these drums and the abacus belonged to the earlier mud-brick temple B 800-I, which is therefore to be assigned definitely to Piankhy.

At the stairway in "SW" corner B 801 removed drums of 2nd Pavement f. c. blocking the lower end of stair, and started cleaning the mud brick walls at top of stair.

## (3) B 501

March 5th: -- Stared clearing out brick intrusive walls in B 501, in following areas: -- I5, 6, 7, II 5, 6, 7, III 4, 5, 6, 7, IV 4, 5, 6, 7, V 5, 6, 7, and VI 6, 7.
