c-d-e = late rough stone wall over the partially destroyed Pylon.

a-b = a subsidiary cross wall belonging to the building c-d-e and lying on top of + parallel to the "W" face of Pylon.

(3) Stair in B 801 : -- Further examination and clearing of foundations at
March 10th lower end of stair built against E face of Pylon I.

[Drawing]

a = Found. Trench of Pylon filled with debris of red sandstone in spills cut through b + c
b = Mud packing on which stair was built (made for stair) earlier than a - d, later than c.

c = Crude brick masonry, now appears to be part of a wall older than stair.

d = Found. trench in which red stone wall (501-II) was built, filled with debris different from that of a

e = The "W" side of stair was removed when the Pylon was built and rebuilt after the construction of the pylon.
