The basin in 108 is heavily cemented and was apparently a vat or bath.

The walls in 113, 114, 115 are only foundations—no doorways are visible. The pottery resembles the Barkal Pyr. wares but with some different forms, some similar. In 112, were frags. of several B/T. bowls (--not M.E. Kerma B.T.). The floors of these sub-rooms must have been only a little below the floors of 100. Below the walls is a thin layer of dust and dirt and then alluvial sand and mud. The earth is now very damp and
