The space between this floor level and the bottoms of the stones forming the steps is filled with hard packed mud, both at bottom and at top of existing portion of the stair. In the foundation course of pavement II, resting on pavement I, the second stone, ie the stone immediately behind the projecting one, and adjacent to the stair on the "E" (exposed by removal of bottom step), is a segment of a column drum, curved face "W", and bears a frag. of incised inscription between two vertical lines.
