Examining walls and floors.
In 1233 (Anlaman) there is a crude brick wall
under floor on "S". A floor about 50cm below
Anlaman floor

In 1236 (later than Anlaman), a wall under floor
x frags. large pot
with bronze slack ?

[Drawing]

Wall x4 closed
doorways of 1236
and 1235 and
1234 (already overbuilt
by 1235).
Wall x1 blocked
stairways 1243, 1244,
Wall x2 seems
absolutely purposeless
Wall x3 cuts off
1239. Thus x2 and
x3 seem bits of walls put in to complete
foundations of higher walls.
The walls ([Drawing]) in 1239 and
the stone pavements (S) and
the col. (e) appear older
than Anlaman.

rooms only.
