(1) B 200 Jan. 14. "N" Put in another small gang at B 200 front. Another block of masonry appears a few meters farther "S".

Roadway

Apparently a roadway¹² as in front of B 700, "S" of B 900, -- perhaps the same. The blocks of Men-Kheper(?)-Ra had been reused in this "roadway". At x is another similar block from the top of [Drawing] a column, but the details are concealed by the other stones.

(2) B 500 Jan. 14. Early this morning reached the frag of wall and two large pots at end of preliminary trenches ("Western" three, "S" of 502) and had to turn dump \rightarrow "SE": Cutting new trenches in this direction proceeding in red sand (gebel). Excavating the mound at end of "W" trenches, found a scrap of mud wall and just beyond that a depression.

In 502, main work without any special development. Col. III "S" (b) lies upset in sand. It was badly weathered before its fall.
