

- (1) B 200 Put in another small gang at B 200 front.
 Jan. 14. Another block of masonry appears a few meters
 "N" farther "S".
Roadway

Apparently a roadway¹² as in
 front of B 700, "S" of B 900, -- perhaps the same.
 The blocks of Men-Kheper(?) - Ra had been
 reused in this "roadway". At x is another
 similar block
 from the top of [Drawing]
 a column, but the
 details are concealed by the other stones.

- (2) B 500 Early this morning reached the frag of
 Jan. 14. wall and two large pots at end of preliminary
 trenches ("Western" three, "S" of 502) and had
 to turn dump → "SE": Cutting new trenches
 in this direction proceeding in red sand
 (gebel). Excavating the mound at end of
 "W" trenches, found a scrap of mud wall
 and just beyond that a depression.

In 502, main work without any
 special development. Col. III "S" (b) lies upset
 in sand. It was badly weathered before its fall.
