(March 10) (41)

Col. Jackson came in the Water-Lily about 2:30. Mr. & Mrs. Crowfoot who lunched with him and Mr. Young [?]. Our whole party went from here. Went to Kuru. Bank crowded with village people; small boys waving green sticks and shouting "ubsh" (<u>ubshir</u>). When we reached the top of the bank, girls of the village began dancing. This is the first time any of our party has seen village dancing (i.e. by respectable people). The little girls wore only the rabat [?], the largest wore a cloth but were naked to the waist.

Rode up to pyramids.
