It is yet uncertain whether the hard packed red sand is part of the pyr. filling or merely washed down from above.

(3) Pyramid XVI is the western of the two "<u>pyramides ruines</u>" shown by Cailliaud on PI. XLIX (map). It was a low mound of drift sand and frags of red sandstone. The whole was cleared, showing the lower part of the retaining wall of the core of a small pyramid. (⁵x meters). Height ca. 100m. On the south or towards the river was a wall of <u>burnt</u> brick, apparently remains of a chapel. On this same side an incline with
