Returned early (about 4:10) to Merowe and all went riding after tea. A great pleasure to ride through "official town" with its avenues of trees and green hedges. Native quarter, a great surprise as to cleanliness and regularity,--a sort of model town. Saw men at work building mosque tower, boys with schoolmaster playing football match. Various effendis walking
