debris. Here the thieves evidently refilled
the hole which they dug. The stones are
apparently from the chapel and the pyg.
casing. Therefore this plundering took
place when ^{some} damage had already been
done to the Pyg. The pyg. was damaged
when Leailhann saw it and the weathering
shows the damage is old.

The chapel is also finished usual form
and is ~~at~~ ^{has} present the best preserved reliefs.
Some previous excavator has penetrated the
N. wall of the chapel into the pyramid.
An irregular narrow hole runs past the
middle of the pyg. (masonry clear through.)
