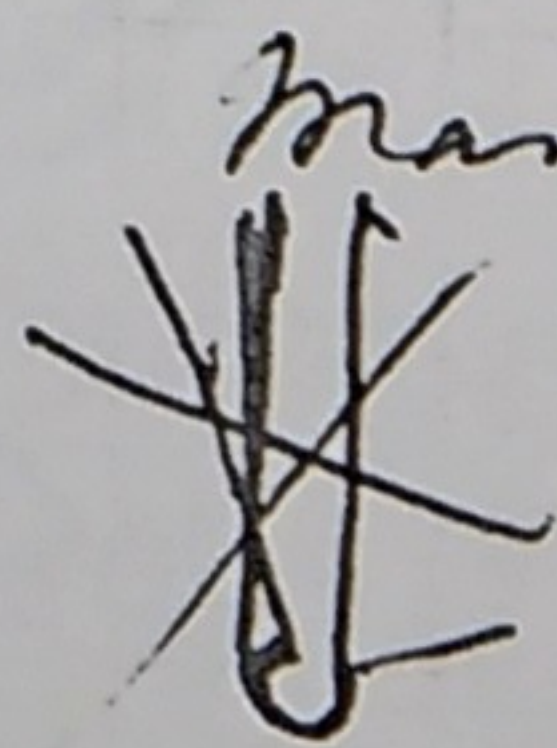

considerable batter. The size of some of fragments shows Pylon must be destroyed nearly to base.

N.B. At the end of the fourth week, the end of the Pyramid excavation is nearing completion, and the preliminary work of excavation at the temple is in hand.

The Pyramids are in three groups
Group I¹ Pys. IX-XV, XX, XXI, XXIII, XXIV
and XXV. Group I² Pys. XVI-XIX, XXII.
Group II Pys. I-VIII. All are certainly
Memphitic. For convenience we will divide
the ~~Memphitic~~^{Aethiopic} period for present purposes,
into three parts:—(a) Tabarka ~~Period~~
Period (Piankhi, Tabarka, Esphant, and
immediate successors), 750 to 500 B.C.
