Locals.

63rd Day of work: -- Work on (1) B 501 "W" end, (2) B 501 "SW" corner.

High north wind with much driving sand starting at sunrise and continuing intense all morning, but moderating in the afternoon. After the breakfast rest on the works, locals were dismissed for the day owing to unfavorable weather. The Egyptians continued in the morning.

(1) B 501 "W" end: -- Work of cleaning up in area VIII 4, nothing to report.
Feb 20th From beginning of work to breakfast rest only.

(2) B 501 "SW" corner: -- During the morning The Egyptians worked at removing
Feb 20th piled up blocks fallen from walls + pylon in areas
VII 1, VIII 1, IX 1, VIII 2, and IX 2

On Feb 19th in area B 502 EX 3, noted a detached red sandstone block leaning against exterior wall of temple with frags. two cartouches thus: --
