(3) Work continues at 900, where the greater part of the gangs are now engaged.

At present these buildings are discernible, in chronological order as follows

- (a) mud-brick walls, to which appear to belong certain white sandstone pavements and columns (one in place)
- (b) well built red sandstone walls.
- (c) mixed stone walls with many reused inscribed blocks
