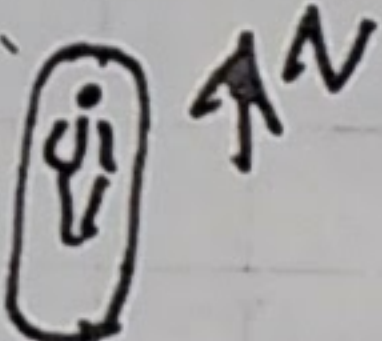

After finishing trial, ~~the~~ near X, the <sup>57</sup>56  
gang was shifted to Pyramid IX.  
and the debris was partially cleared  
from this (Cailland Py. i in  
southern group). See Pl. XLIX i and  
Pl. L VII in left. In Cailland time this  
Pyramid was practically intact.

③ Work continued on X. In the  
bank of hard sand on the east, was  
a long pit with a small skeleton (child)  
badly decayed.  It being  
manifest that the <sup>eastern</sup>~~southern~~ face  
was ~~not~~ preserved started clearing  
southern side between ~~X~~ X and XV.  
Revealed part of retaining wall of  
one of X and struck the edge of a  
shaft (3) just west of middle.

④ Clearing away <sup>low</sup> mound of rubbish  
east of XVI which I have marked XVII  
(see p. 49). This is the western pass. marked  
by Cailland "pyr. mines". <sup>only trace of the</sup> The ~~superstructure~~
