The upper part (from 50-100cm) of the back of 203-205 was built of masonry.

Bad places in rock in 203 and 205 had been repaired with masonry. Probably upper part (over half) of 201 had been built of masonry.

The walls were decorated somewhat like B 300. I would assume that B 300 was later.

(2) B 500 Jan. 7. Finished clearing of $504 \underline{a}$. It is obvious that the red wall of the last temple was built over the older walls (those of oldest period, these of Ramesses period, and these
