There appears, from the examination of the sub-floor deposits in 1230, 1246, 1245 1239, 1238, 1236, to have been one building earlier than Anlaman-Aspalta structure (or structures). The crude brick of the earlier walls are formless, (i.e. either coalesced by pressure on galûs). The a-a bricks have a large amount of dark sand in the mixture.

There are at least two main structures after the ruin of the a-a structure (or structures) but there are a number of other walls which may or may not be repairs of the main late structures.

Wall III (the second in date) of 1201-1205 belongs to the A-A structure.
