Jan. 24) The difference in level between the Tirhaqa
and the old floor (Thothmes?) is about
110-120 cm.

(3) B 500
Jan. 24. Continued clearing B 502. Working now
towards "N" in sections VII to XI. In
X, XI, still in 4; In VII to IX working into 5.
[at "E", 3 rows of
[Drawing] 6 each: then 7 rows
of 4 cols each]

(4) B 502 EX "S"
Jan. 24. Continued trenching along "E" side of rectangular
pit. The wall of the cut is quite irregular both in
plan and in
[Drawing] section. At (x) it
is only about 40 cm
high (deep)
The deposits of potsherds show clear striations
of deposits separated by streaks of fine dirty debris.
I fail to note gravity[?] striations.

(5) B 503
Jan. 24. Continued clearing well. Same alternate
layers of mud and olive sand.
[Drawing] The examination
of the cleared
ground has also
exposed a founda
tion trench which from the debris once contained
a mud brick wall (crude brick). I think
this is the enclosing wall corresponding to that
discerned on the "S".

(6) B 1200
Jan. 24. Work went on as usual in 1200. We
have now started the RW dumping over[?]
1201-4.
