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Saturday March 11 42 day of work

Went with Mr. & Mrs. Crowfoot and Dunham to Nuri by launch. Sand storm blowing since about midnight. From Kareima we went up the west side of the river, and, when we tried to cross over opposite Nuri, we got amongst sand banks and only after nosing about for an hour and sending Abd-el-Megid wading did we manage to get over. Found our donkies and the camels for the Crowfoods at the saqiah of Kha [?] Mohammed Abdullah. Rode to the pyramids in blinding sand storm.

This field is the most important of all the pyramid fields in the neighborhood. Assuming that the royal group Piankhi, Taharka, Espalut, etc are buried in this region, their royal cemetery would be the most important one in the region. Up to the present then the probability is that Nuri is their place. Otherwise I have not yet seen their place.
