④ Nuri Pyramids:-
March 7th

Report received from party at Nuri under Metawali.
At Pyr XV. The pavement has been taken up at the "NW" and "SW" corners, and further search made for deposits but without success. No trace of the 2 "W" deposits has as yet been found.

At XVI. Search was made for F.D.s, but none could be located.

At Pyr XVII. Here, after search, a deposit of bones was found at one corner, but it is uncertain whether this is to be considered as belonging to an F.D. until after examination by Dr. Reisner.

Dr. Reisner ordered the party to return, except Hassan, who remains as guard.

Work on ① Merotic walls in B 501. ② B 802, ③ B 801.

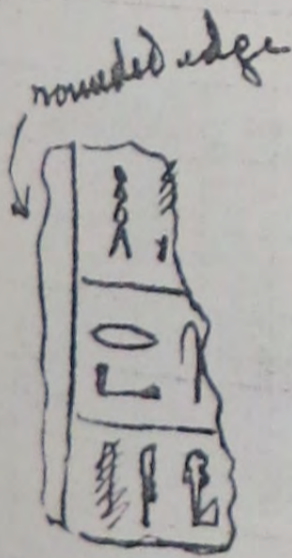
① Merotic Walls B 501:-
March 8th :-

Work continued removing merotic brick walls and debris beneath them.

From area VI 6 upper left corner of a slate slab with figure of prone bound captive incised, which fits on 20-2-168 found in area B 501 Ex., Feb 24th.

Also from this area a small frag. grey granite with the ends of three horizontal lines of inscription (Probably another frag. of the Cairo Pankley Stele)

From VIII 2 frag of a large black stone slab with 2 crudely incised merotic cartouches and a vulture with outspread wings.



② B 802
March 8th

Took up II pavement in centre of room B 802, where there was a sunk place (pavement settled into a hollow) and wained ground beneath. At ca 1 meter below floor reached a hard black mud "gel".
