In the angle, is a small room of the
later small masonry built against the
older wall. The floor is a hard crust
(unbroken). No doorway is visible.

The masonry at X is as follows:



So far as preserved. The stones are large
and poorly dressed. Around the corner
at Y, the small masonry (beautifully
square stones laid in grey mortar, harder
than the stone) is as follows.



We have cleared along a surface of hard sandstone
debris (natural?) washed down from the Gebel.
