Tuesday March 21 50th working day

Worked ceased at Merowe Temple and a gang sent to start at Nûri.

Arrived at Barkal 7:45 and dropped Dunham and Kemp on the bank. I went on to Nuri. The engine got hot. I row[ed] in to the bank and the two boys towed the boat about 300 yds. upstream to the R R shops. Mr. Riches found the water pipes clogged and valve worn, and very kindly fixed the engine for me. Left shops at 10:30, landed at the sagiah of Moh. Kha[?] Abdullah and reached Nuri pyramids about 11:15.
