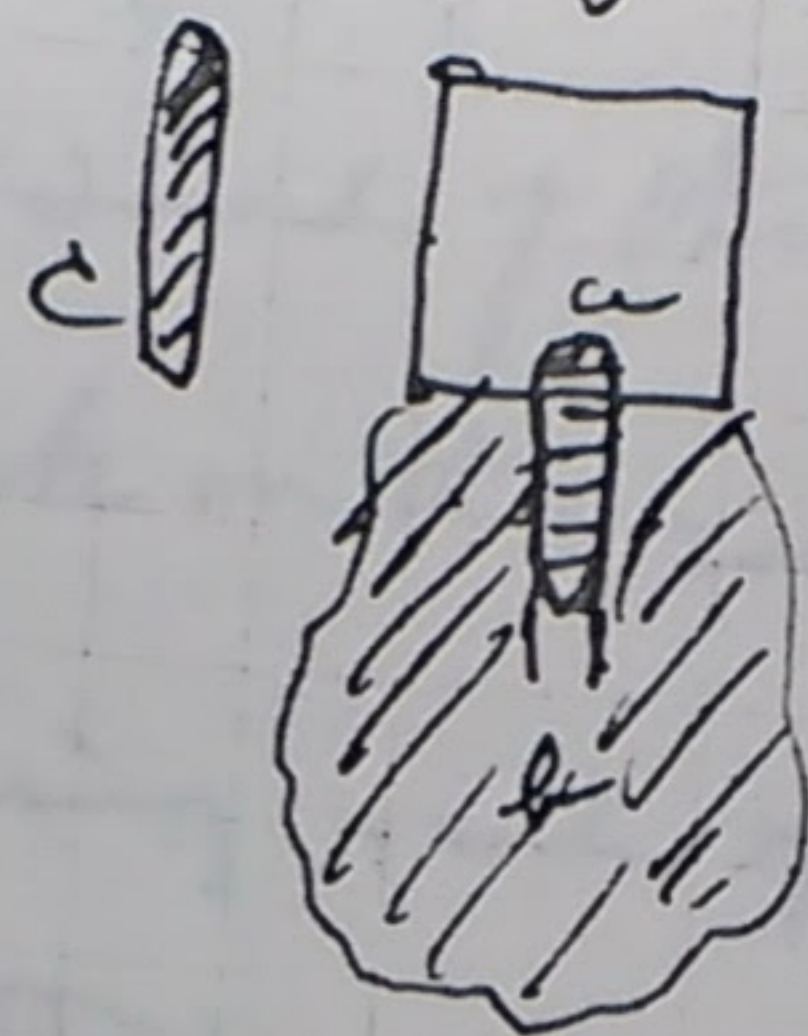

① Searching for entrance to IX further south.

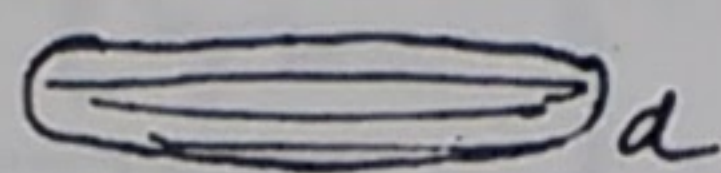

(c) trench cleared by us on E.



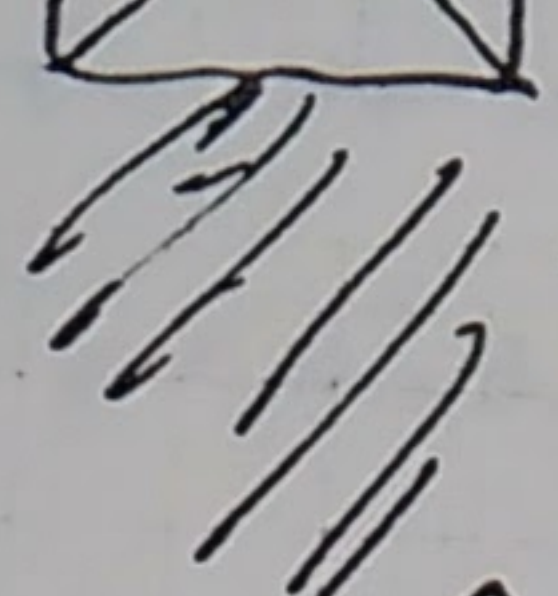
(d) new trench

N.B. On the rock there is about 50-80 cm of water packed detritus, not differing in color or consistency from the original filling of the stairways. It is therefore necessary to trench along the surface of the rock itself to find the stairway.
