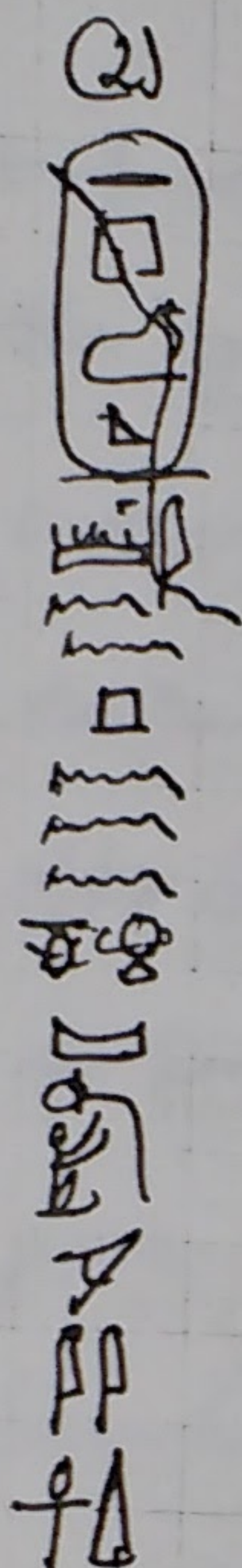
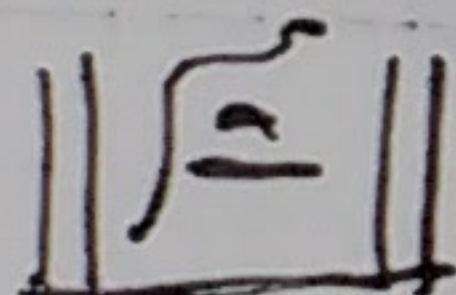

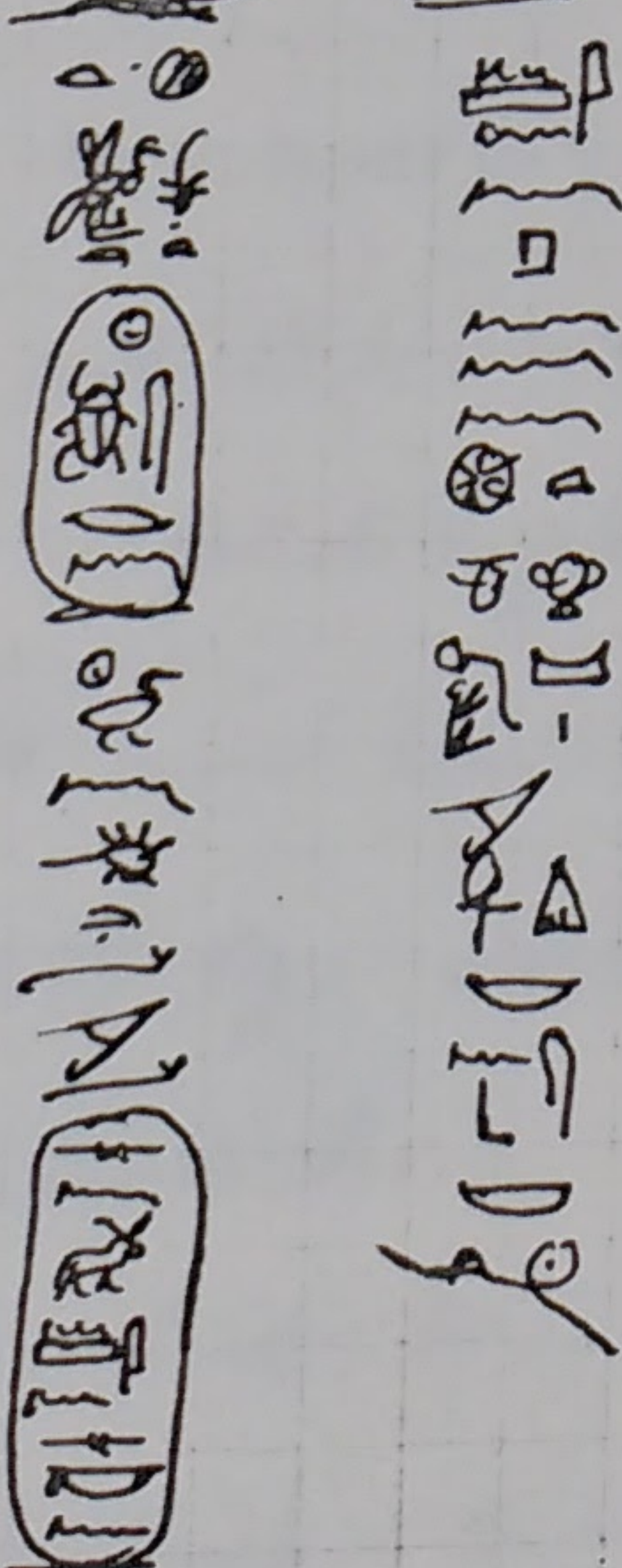


No. 3 is ~~also~~ a grey granite statue similar to the one 48. of the Nend of the Great temple (in a hole; head at home). The same thick heavy work. Head 1 seems to belong to this (same material and workmanship). The head was covered with plaster and painted (hence the unfinished appearance).

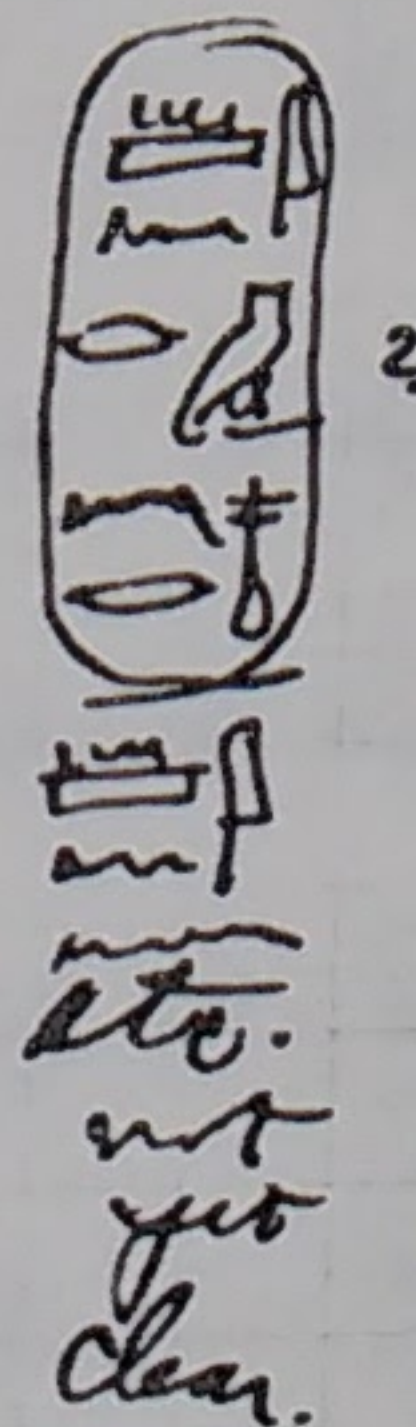


No. 4 is a smaller figure (life size) of a male, standing left foot advanced, head missing, garments left rough to take paint.

No. 5 is like No. 4 in size material & workmanship, but is a female (feet together). Only part of the inscription is visible



Head 2 probably belongs to the Tabarka statue.
