Locals, -- 135
Railway material practically arrived at sunset.
I ran survey line from Peg (1) at pyramids
down to front of temple 300. Most
of the pegs in the line (1) to (7) have been eaten
by white ants including no. (1) which had to be
reset from 2 and 4. Nos. 5, 6, 8, and 9
were preserved. From (1) to (205) is 150+270+80
meters = 500 meters.

Work on (1) B 502 (2) B 504 a
(3) B 1200

(1) B 502
Jan. 5.

Continued trenches "S" of 502 for ca. ___ meters
to "S" of enclosing wall, where the gebel rises
to another ridge running out from Gebel Barkal.

No walls or other indications of buildings were
found until the rising ground appeared.
Here on the extreme "S" were a few stones
perhaps a rough wall and three round mud [?]
pots or "magurs"[?] with ashes perhaps
potter's kilns.

From the middle of "S" wall of 502 started
switching a RR embankment → "SSE".

(2) B 504 a
Jan. 5.

In order to get stone for RR, began clearing
"W" end of room 504 a. The room is blocked
close beside the column by a later wall. If
we had worked on another 20 min. in 1916
we would have exposed this later wall.
