No walls or other indications of buildings were found until the rising ground appeared. Here on the extreme "S" were a few stones perhaps a rough wall and three round mud [?] pots or "magurs"[?] with ashes perhaps potter's kilns.

From the middle of "S" wall of 502 started switching a RR embankment \rightarrow "SSE".

(2) B 504 <u>a</u> Jan. 5. In order to get stone for RR, began clearing "W" end of room $504 \, \underline{a}$. The room is blocked close beside the column by a later wall. If we had worked on another 20 min. in 1916 we would have exposed this later wall.
