Finished examination of Pyr. B VIII  
all parts are filled  
with gravel held by  
a double layer, retaining wall  
built pari passu with  
filling.

Step I was a platform  
on which the actual  
stepped pyr. II-III was  
built. The "west" front  
of II is destroyed in the  
middle but I restore  
with niche and chapel  
[N.B. the triad from the  
niche was found at x near  
the base of step II]

The two parallel walls built against the  
"N" end of the "W" face of I are undoubtedly  
the remains of a slope or stair leading  
from the ground to the chapel on step. I.
