Work continued at Building 500
Trench A. The clearing on the
Mavritio floor is now $22\frac{1}{2}$ m (N-S)
by 17 meters (E-W) but we are still
some 5 m. from the Pylon. Fragments
of the corner masonry of the Pylon ¹⁴⁹¹ ~~1494~~
are appearing. They have been cemented
after the manner of Building 100, but
over a weathered surface. That means
the cementing represents a ^{late} Mavritio
restoration of the temple - after a
