

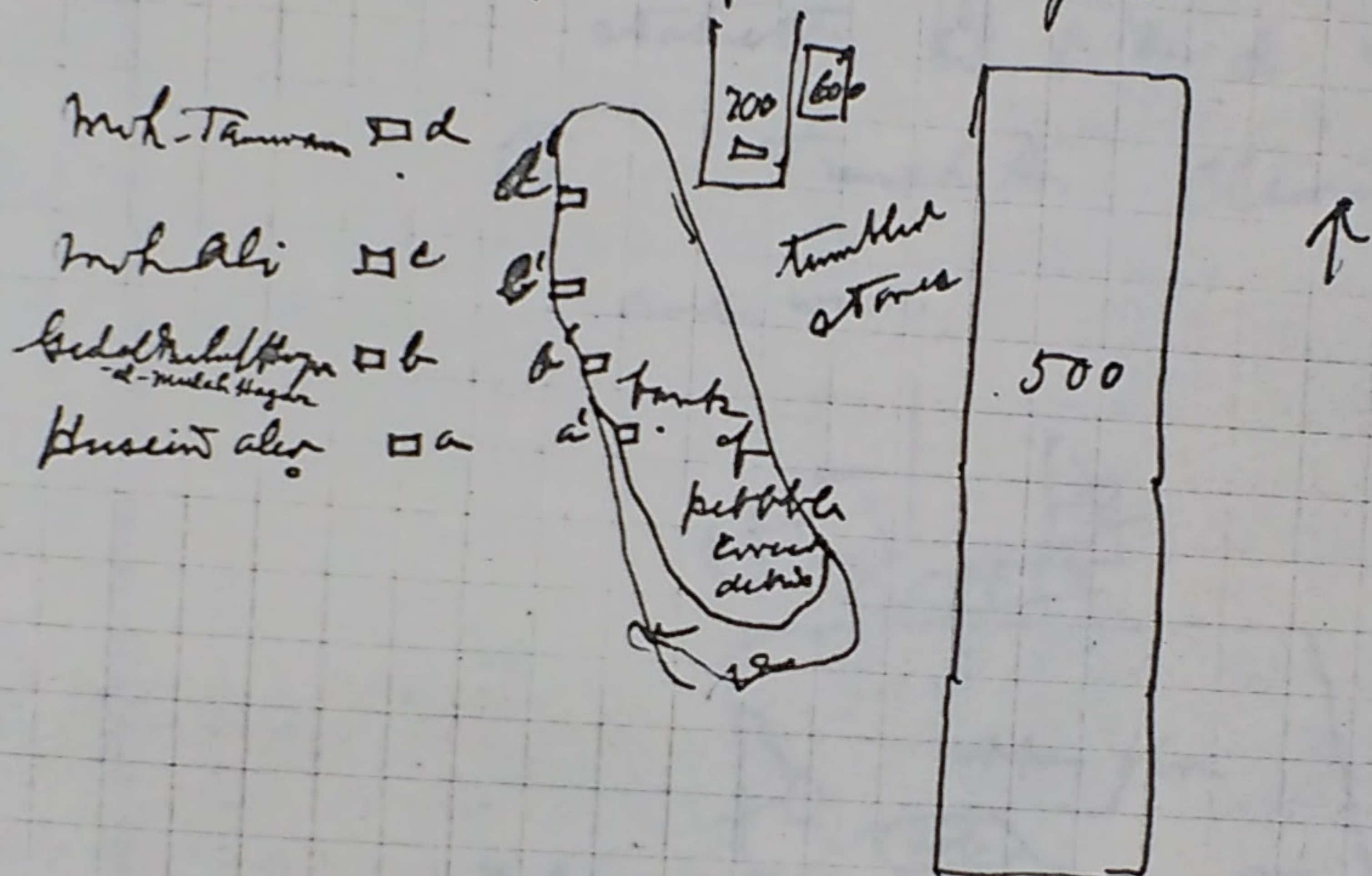

I have put in ~~some~~ ^{four} pits a. b. c. d. in the
low ground west of the "bank of debris" and four
~~in the~~ (a', b', c', d') in the edge of the "bank of debris".
In the trenches a-d there is about 100-120 cm
of dark (dry) dust and dirt with some potsherds;
below this comes loose red sand (probably
natural deposit). In b, a rough masonry
wall (20 cm high) in dirt runs E-W.
In the trenches a'-d', dirt, drifted dust, etc.
The white pebbles are only on the surface,
and thus give a deceptive appearance
