②. Bldg 600. Breaking and carrying at fallen cliff.

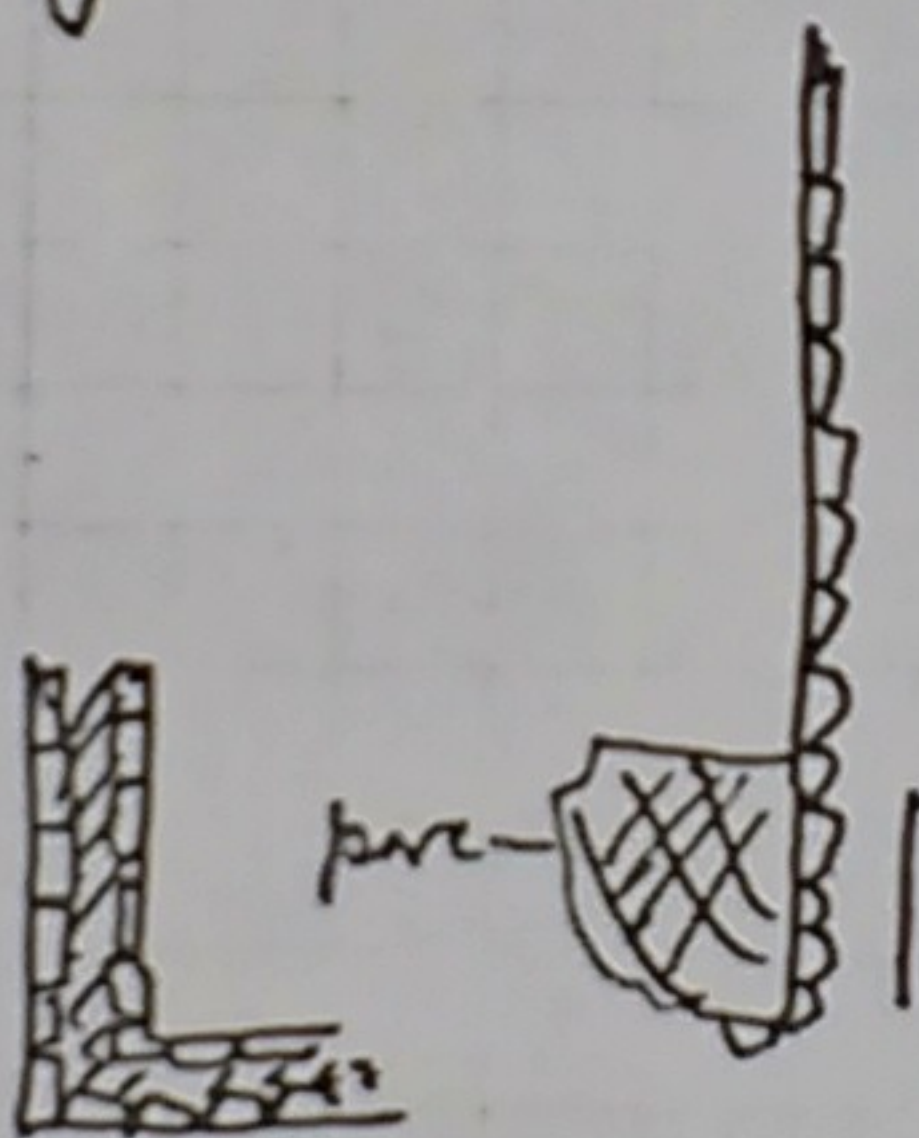

③. Bldg 400.

Blended to red sand stratum - surface uneven - broken by settlement and stone thierces.



④. Bldg. 900. This building is on a hill and so destroyed for stone that no plan can be drawn until more is excavated. We are now clearing → R along N. side and have again picked up the street running → R. # Many very late pot shards (Christian ?) in the debris of 900.
