Under the D. side of 703 are parts of two walls of red sandstone. (no[t] same width). These were revealed in clearing the intrusive trench on the D-side of 703. In the trench, a large undressed block of stone. Under this block, potsherds [DRAWING/finger marks] and a mud figure of a ram (broken incomplete).

The fallen columns in 703 <u>all</u> had the name of Atlanersa. There are also five or six blocks with crude hieroglyphics in relief (background colored blue), of which one frag. has the name of Atlanersa.
