- (3) B 901 "S" wall. Started examination of exterior supporting wall ("S") of B 901-II
March 12th

a = face of 1st red wall (901-I)
b = face of 2nd " " (901-II)
c = 2 f.c.'s of 2nd wall, many being
reused inscribed blocks.

These f.c. blocks (c) have a square section and are very long. One was
found inscribed as follows [Drawing: Hieroglyphs]

- (4) "NW" of B 1000 : -- Work cleaning and clearing in detail
March 12th to the "NW" of the great well B 1000.

- (5) B 902 : -- Work in the "SW" corner of B 902, tracing the 1st red wall
March 12th at this point. (belongs to Red I on "S" of B 903-910)

The part enclosed in circle cleared today, being
a moulded corner of red sandstone in line
with the 1st red wall as at a. The corner and
"NS" wall b runs over a, and a doorway
at c is filled up with debris but clearly
traceable. The inside corner of the wall
a a is not as yet clear.
