The part enclosed in circle cleared today, being a moulded corner of red sandstone in line with the 1st red wall as at <u>a</u>. The corner and "NS" wall <u>b</u> runs over <u>a</u> <u>a</u>, and a doorway at <u>c</u> is filled up with debris but clearly traceable. The inside corner of the wall
