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period of neglect. Thus the evidence points again to a long abandonment of the site between the Tabarka ~~and~~ period (including his immediate successors) and the late Merutis period (that of the Pyramids in all probability). The objects found in the debris above the floor are all late Merutis.

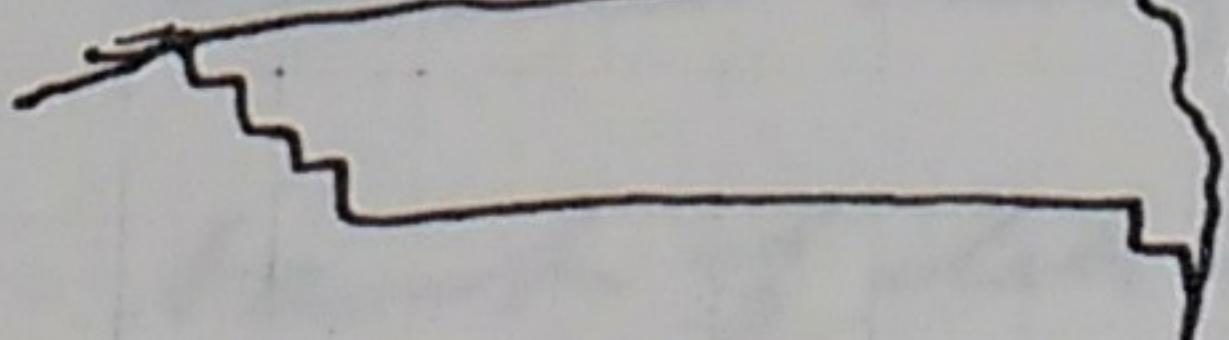
