(2)	Bldg 600. Breaking and carrying out fallen cliff. 600 A has crossed from 500 D to the U-wall of 600 without showing any trace of any construction. 600 B has crossed from 700 to beyond the line of the U-wall of 600 without showing any construction.
(3)	Bldg. 400. [DRAWING] Cleared to red sand stratum—surface uneven—broken by <u>sebbaḥîn</u> and stone thieves.
(4)	Bldg. 900. This building is on [XX?]built and so destroyed for stone that no plan can be drawn until more is excavated. We are now clearing R along U-side and have again picked up the street running R. Many very late potsherds (Christian?) in the debris of 900.
