Tuesday Feb. 8<sup>th</sup> 14<sup>th</sup> day

Work on (1) Pyr. XI, (2) Pyr. XV, (3) XXIV, [(4) not listed], (5) XVIII, (6) XIX, (7) Building 100, (8) outside Great Temple in 3 places.

(1) Continued clearing of 1<sup>st</sup> chamber under Pyr. XI. Continued clearing debris & fallen blocks from before E face of XI, the faxing blocks in place to ca 5-6 m. at centre of this face.

(2) Continued clearing chambers under XV. [DRAWING] 3 chambers of about equal size & shape, slightly narrower than N end of approach cutting. The last chamber containing bench in centre for the burials (solid rock), and a small niche high up in the north wall (empty). In debris of this last room, thin bronze bowl, broken & bent D ca. 10-12 cm. Frag. of larger cyl. jar (ware uncertain) [DRAWING]
