Nos. 111, 112, 113 are inaccessible compartments without doors (or apparent stairs). They were manifestly foundations compartments. The walls and square pillars must have carried the walls and the columns of the more important upper story. The part now preserved was therefore a ground floor devoted to subsidiary uses.
