Jan. 10. The small gang in front of B 200 proceeds
slowly. I think there is clearly masonry
just under the terrace but whether steps
or something else is unclear.

(2) B 500
Jan. 10. Work proceeding as before.
Outside "S" wall. An old surface has
been exposed, on which the last red
wall was built. This surface runs
out to the mud-brick wall (W. ca. 50 cm)
and is cut by numerous

modern times.

Inside, clearing proceeds working from
doorway to 503 backwards to RR.
