(3) Clearing front of 600. Mass of dirty debris mixed with mud and broken mud bricks, stones, etc. This disturbed stratum runs [?] under 601. Under this stratum and directly in front of 601, in the red sand bank, was a shallow burial, contracted [?] on right side head GD (due West) (West is locally called East ac't<sup>53</sup> of river). If C [?]-group people were also confused by flow of river, the burial was C-group orientation as well as position. The grave was filled with clear red sand and
