Work on (1) B 501 EX 1 (2) B 501 back walls,
(3) B 802, (4) Nuri Pyramids.

(1) B 501 EX 1: --
March 7th

Cleared away sand and sandstone debris from immediately
"S" of doorway in "S" wall of B 501, exposing doorblock.
The block is of a rubble of mixed burnt brick and stone +
stone chips, and rests on a pavement (?) of yellow-brown
sandstone, considerably higher than general level of stone pave-
ment inside B 501. The explanation of this point must await
clearing inside this doorway.

(2) B 501 brick walls : --
March 7th

Work continued clearing out brick walls and debris
beneath them in areas as follows : -- I 1; II 1, 2; III 1, 2;
IV 1, 2, 3; V 1, 2, 3, VI 6, VII 6.

In area V 1, beneath the brick walls, came on red
sandstone drum of a column (a complete drum, smaller
in diameter than the existing columns in B 501) with the
*lower part of an incised cartouche of Taharka faintly legible.

(3) B 802 : --
March 7th

Removed part of pavement II, B 802 for examination
of column basis of B 802-II, preserved below pavement.
Column No b¹.
