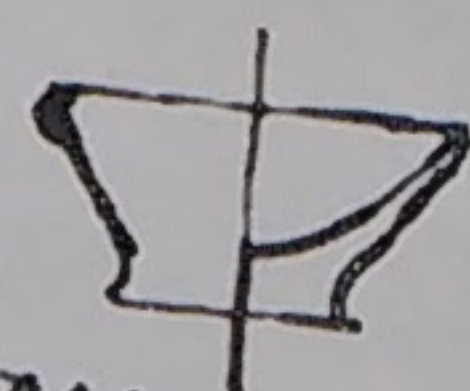

hole - not laid out in order.

No inscription is visible on any of
the objects. The bronze might
be XVIIIth dyn., but the pottery
looks later (ca XXth). However
the material is scanty, and
the conclusion must be used with
caution.
